ARRA Title I Funds

- ARRA allocation can be found on the Allotment page of the ARRA NCLB application – includes carryover and prepayments from FY10 only
- All the regular Title I requirements still apply:
 - Serving buildings in rank-order of poverty
 - Setting aside funds for SES, choice, professional development
 - Equitable share for private schools
 - Etc.

Submitting the regular NCLB application first still works best

- The ARRA application Targeting pages are controlled by the regular Title I application
- ARRA Steps 1 – 3 display what has been entered on the regular Title I application – if it has been submitted to ISBE

Why is my regular allotment showing as \$0 on ARRA Step 4?

- When final regular Title I allocations were loaded in late August, it zeroed allocation data on Targeting Step 4
- If your regular NCLB application was approved before August 24, create and submit a regular NCLB amendment – this should correct the display on the ARRA NCLB application
- If the correct amounts are showing on Targeting Step 4 for an approved regular NCLB application BUT the amount on ARRA is displaying as \$0, ISBE should return the ARRA application for you to re-submit – after verifying the accuracy of both regular and ARRA Step 4

Why is there nothing showing?

- In order for data to display on this page, a regular application must have been completed and submitted (or marked as Final)
- The regular application must be under the control of ISBE for data to show – has it been returned to the district for changes?

How can the data on the Redisplay of Regular Step 4 page be changed?

- The data **cannot** be changed on the ARRA Redisplay page
- Changes would have to be made on the regular application
- This is ONE program, so all the enrollment and targeting information should be the same as was entered on the regular application

Regular and ARRA Combined Targeting Step 4

- Use this page to adjust set-asides, per pupil amounts and/or attendance centers served to reflect the increased funding as a result of ARRA funds – it's the only Step 4 page in ARRA with a SAVE button
- The allocation on this page includes funds from both the regular and ARRA Title I grants, including carryover if the regular Title I application has incorporated it
- Regular and ARRA allocations are combined when determining set-aside requirements – and all the usual requirements apply
- Keep reporting requirements in mind as you determine how ARRA funds will be distributed

How does the reviewer know how the ARRA funds are distributed? Start with Redisplay of Regular Step 4

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Regular and ARRA Combined Targeting Step 4 - continued

- Once the combined funds have been distributed and the page successfully saved, the ARRA Allocation Distribution – Step 4 page should display how *just* the ARRA funds were distributed
- If the Regular and Combined page has NOT been successfully saved (which includes getting rid of any red **ERROR: Data Not Saved messages**), the ARRA Allocation Distribution page will NOT display properly

How to unlock a page marked as Final

- The application must be in the hands of the district
- Call ISBE consultant and request the page be unlocked
- The ISBE consultant can then unlock the page
- We have eliminated the “Consulting” feature on regular NCLB grants
- The “Mark as Final” is not always working this year – avoid it if at all possible

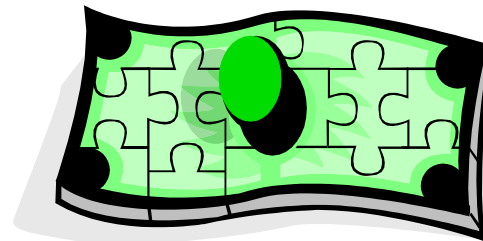

Who Does What – ISBE Call Center

Who Does What – Program Consultants

- Serve as point of contact for regular Titles I, II-A and IV applications & ARRA Title I
- Complete Review Checklists during the grant review process
- Determine whether an application is programmatically approvable
- Determine whether costs are allowable
- Unlock pages marked as Final
- Address any other program issues such as private school share, eligible attendance centers showing up on Targeting Step 4, etc.

Q: How do I find out who my consultant is?

- The list of consultants and their respective regions is posted on the Innovation and Improvement website at http://www.isbe.net/grants/pdf/nclb_pc_reg_asmt.pdf

Q: If we request a Print All, when and how will we know it is available?

- There will be a link to the PDF document on the organization select screen (right side of screen, below the PRINT ALL button).
- Print requests may take up to several hours depending on demand for conversion to a PDF
- No longer an overnight process unless demand is heavy

Q: Carry over ARRA funds must be spent by what date?

- All ARRA funds must be spent by September 30, 2011

Q: If Title IID or Title IVA have prepayments in FY10, will those amounts be brought over to FY11?

- Yes

Q: If we carried over Title IID funds, they should appear on the Allotment Page. Will I be able to complete a Title IID grant budget on the FY2011 NCLB Consolidated Application?

- Yes

Q: Where are the ARRA waiver pages?

- Waivers were only applicable during the first year of ARRA funds (FY10) so the waiver pages have been removed from the FY11 ARRA application
